### **ALISHA SANDERS**

**Director of Housing and Services Policy Research  
Office of the LeadingAge LTSS Center @UMass Boston  
Washington, D.C.**

Alisha Sanders' work focuses on identifying, evaluating, and advancing strategies and policies that link affordable housing settings with health and supportive services to enable older adults with lower incomes to successfully age in their homes and communities. Prior to joining LeadingAge, Sanders was associate director of Public Policy for Aging Services of California, where she advocated for improved, affordable housing opportunities for older Californians. She holds a master's degree in Public Affairs from the Lyndon B. Johnson School of Public Affairs at the University of Texas.



### **PETER A. BOLING, M.D.**

**Professor of Internal Medicine  
Chair, Division of Geriatric Medicine  
Virginia Commonwealth University**

Peter Boling, M.D., has focused on geriatric education and on improving care of people with advanced chronic illness with a focus on home-based care. During his tenure at Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU), he helped develop a 180-physician independent practice association and led the Division of General Medicine for six years before becoming the Chair of the Division of Geriatric Medicine. He was instrumental in developing the Independence at Home Act (IHA), which became section 3024 of the Accountable Care Act. VCU is partnering with the University of Pennsylvania and Medstar Washington Hospital Center in the mid-Atlantic IAH Consortium. This is one of 19 IAH sites in the United States. He attended Amherst College and received his Doctor of Medicine degree from the University of Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry with a student pathology fellowship.
